## How points are scored

If you predict Carlisle to finish 5<sup>th</sup> and they finish 2<sup>nd</sup>, you collect 3 penalty points (the difference between 5 and 2) for Carlisle. This is done for each team; the winner will be the entrant with the lowest total. In the event of a tie, the entrant who predicted the eventual champions closest to 1<sup>st</sup> will win. If there is still a tie then the entrant predicting the runners-up closest to 2<sup>nd</sup> will win and so on.
